

Actor Released After Spree as Bean-Shooter

The City Attorney's office in West Los Angeles yesterday declined to issue a complaint against Actor Bobby Driscoll, 19, who was jailed with a young friend Wednesday night after a bean-shooting spree in Westwood Village when one of their pellets struck a woman in the face.

The woman, Mrs. Eloise Patricia Sherrill of 11743 Sunset Blvd., and her husband, Palmer, made a citizen's arrest of Driscoll and his friend after Mrs. Sherrill was hit. But yesterday the woman said she had changed her mind about prosecuting the youths.

Arrested with Driscoll, who gave his address as 16542 Chattanooga Place, Pacific Palisades, was Lester A. Ferguson, 20, a service-station attendant of 3255 Military Ave., West Los Angeles. Shortly after they were jailed the youths were released on \$250 bail each.

When Mrs. Sherrill refused to prosecute yesterday all charges against Driscoll and Ferguson were dropped and their bail was exonerated.
