

Bobby Driscoll Now Cleared of Felony

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Ex-child movie actor Bobby Driscoll has been cleared of felony assault charges.

However, he faces in Malibu court June 30 a hearing on an assault and battery misdemeanor writ obtained by Laurie Mauro. Mauro claims Driscoll, 23, struck him with a pistol. Sheriff's deputies say the fracas occurred when Mauro and a friend heckled Driscoll, who was washing a girl friend's car in nearby Topanga Beach.

Felony charges were dropped Thursday when the district attorney's office failed to issue a complaint.

Driscoll is a native of Cedar Rapids.
