

Driscoll Returns to Jail on Narcotics Possession

LOS ANGELES (UPI)—Former child actor Bobby Driscoll, freed briefly on a forgery charge, was back in jail today on suspicion of possessing narcotics.

The 24-year-old former juvenile star, who won a special Academy Award in 1949 and now calls himself an unemployed laborer, was arrested Monday night when police said he tried to cash a \$45 check with false identification.

stolen in a Jan. 5 liquor-store robbery.

Tuesday a judge freed him on a writ of habeas corpus, but two hours later two cruising policemen noticed him driving erratically on Wilshire Boulevard.

The officers said Driscoll told them that he had just taken two pills for a bursitis condition and said scars on his arms came from grease burns.

Driscoll is to appear in court Thursday on the original forgery charge.
